Course name is the name of your course, and it will appear on reports and in emails to customers.

Peak Season Starts is the month and day your peak season starts. This affects your default sales screen and pricing. If you use our sales module and have the system configured to auto populate the sale with greens fee, the regular greens fee will be used during peak season and winter greens fee during off season.

Off Season Starts is the month and day your off season begins. In this example, we have "1001" which is October 1.

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EDIT DEFAULT TEE TIMES allows you to define your first and last tee time of the day by date range. For each date range, you can specify the first WeekDay Tee Time, first WeekEnd Tee Time, and the Last Tee time.

The first time you view the teesheet for a given date, the tee times for that day are added. Changing your default tee times will not rebuild the teesheet for days you already viewed. To rebuild a teesheet for a day you have already viewed, go to the on the teesheet, click on TEE TIMES ADD and click REBUILD. In this example, the first Weekday tee time is 10:00AM for January 1 to March 31. From April 1 – April 30, the first Weekday tee time is 9:00AM. You can create as many segments as you want. The first segment always has to be January 1.

The Interval is the number of minutes between tee times.

The Carts Warning is a feature that will warn you if you are going to run out of rental carts. You can learn more about the carts warning <u>here</u>.

Show Pricing Columns. If you interface with a booking engine that does dynamic pricing (and interfaces with our teesheet) or if you create your own dynamic pricing, you can choose to show the dynamic pricing on the teesheet. You can have a regular alternate price and a senior alternate price. You can chose to show 0, 1 or both pricing columns.

Copy Pricing to Booking. If you use alternate pricing and someone books on-line, the alternate pricing will be copied to the tee sheet next to the customer's name. This shows you what the customer was quoted. If you want to honor the on-line alternate pricing for walk-ins and people that book over the phone, you will want to check the "Copy Pricing to Booking" checkbox. This will cause the alternate pricing to appear next

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How To – Modify Course Info to the name when you enter the booking yourself.

Enable On Line Bookings. This allows you to disable our booking engine.

Schedule Rule – This is the default number of days out customers can book tee times on line. You can allow certain contact types to login and book more days out. For example, you could allow anyone to book 7 days out, but if a member logs in, they could be allowed to book 14 days out.

Require Email – When customers book on line, you can allow customers to book without entering an email, or you can require a validated email. Depending on your credit card processor and if you have an e-commerce account, you can require customers to have a credit card on file before booking on-line. Learn more <u>here</u>.

Use On-Line Pricing. When someone books a tee time on-line, the booking engine may pass notes that include the price to charge. These notes will appear next to the customer's name on the tee sheet. If there is a price next to their name and this box is checked, then the sale will start with a greens fee for this specified price. This means your employees do not have to remember or enter this price. This requires you to have and On-Line Tee Time item selected in the next field. If you have a "Sell with On-Line Booking" item selected (which is generally a cart), then the sale will start with the On-Line Tee Time item and the Sell With item.

Rewards Percentage determines the percentage of each "loyalty item" purchased the customer gets. Learn more about our loyalty rewards module <u>here</u>.

The TaxRate and TaxRate2 are your states tax rates and is used inventory and sales module. When editing an item, you can specify the tax rate for each item (No Tax, Tax 1 or Tax 2).

Last Close is used to determine when your last accounting period was closed. You will not be allowed to post sales, payments, or adjustments before this date.

Statement Notes are notes that appear on the statements that get printed and/ or emailed.

Receipt Bottom Notes are notes that print on the bottom of each receipt.

The Machine Settings are settings used to tell how Proshop Teetimes should work on a specific computer. For example, POS stations in a Food and Beverage area will not default to the teesheet screen. POS stations in the proshop will not print a tip line on the receipt.
